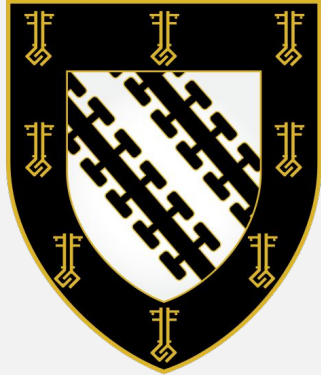


Exeter College MCR Freshers' Week

Punting

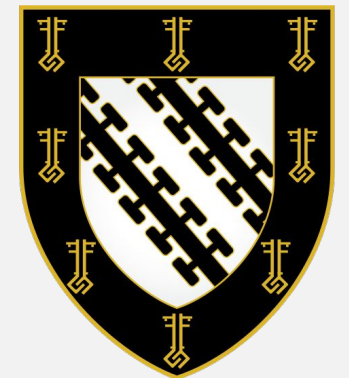
Magdalen Bridge Boathouse
